Legislation — Democratic lawmakers, Fred 'One-Gun-A-Month' Madden (D), have introduced a bill to establish a center at Rutgers University where research on gun violence would be conducted. (No. A4371 & S2830) An Act establishing a Firearm Violence Research Center and supplementing chapter 65 of Title 18A of the New Jersey Statutes. This is a Tax-Payer funded effort to take away Second Amendment rights from the Tax-Payer.
